Turn roaming off, because the use of 4G/5G on the ferry is very expensive as well.

Important business

Passport

Be sure you carry a valid passport.

Pocket money guideline

You will need to have about £50,- with you to spend on meals that are not provided. It is also advisable to bring a bank card with you and withdraw money once we arrive. Withdrawing money is cheaper than exchanging it.

Medication

If you take any medication, please don't forget to bring it with you! It may also be a good idea to bring the original packaging in order to avoid any unnecessary problems with customs.

Insurance

The school has taken out travel insurances for all students going on this trip.

Cambridge group

The group consists of 40 students and 4 teachers. It is of vital importance that we all follow the agreed rules and regulations. Make sure you are always on time at the agreed location. One of the teachers will be your main point of contact, follow them like ducklings.

Each teacher is assigned a group of students. At the back of this booklet you can see which teacher is responsible for your group. That teacher will create a WhatsApp group where they will send instructions about the upcoming activities and mealtimes. Follow these to the letter. Before each departure you have to find your teacher who will then cross you off their list. That way we can make sure that we leave no-one behind.



You can also use the WhatsApp group in case you get lost or if we do accidentally leave you behind!

Each room has private facilities that include a shower and toilet. Bed linen are provided and continental breakfast is included. Reception is manned 24 hours.

Towels are not provided! You'll have to bring your own. Also bring a **travel adaptor** in order to be able to charge your phone.

The youth hostel will charge us money if members of the group misbehave inside or outside the building, are noisy or cause damage to the property. Our rooms will be checked at the end of our stay: any breakages or damages will be charged to your group. Please be warned that if you misbehave or are disruptive and we decide it's necessary, you may be sent home at your parents' expense.

Lights out is at 23:00!

Alcohol/Smoking

During the entire trip the use of alcohol and/or smoking is forbidden. If anyone is caught drinking alcohol or smoking in any part of the hostel, you may be asked to leave the hostel immediately.


